

MRS. CHEDESTER DIES AT HER HOME HERE AFTER LONG ILLNESS

Mrs. Joseph Chedester of East State street died at her home this morning after an illness of many months. She has been so seriously ill that death was not unexpected.

Margaret Teresa Carter was born in Morristown, Tenn., on January 27, 1851, and at her death was 76 years, 9 months and 3 days old. She was married at Morristown, Tenn., on Sept. 16, 1869, to Joseph Chedester, and they went to Barry, Mo., in 1872. There they made their home until they came to Redlands in 1915. Her husband, Capt. Joseph Chedester, is well known here and active in G. A. R. circles.

She leaves six children, three sons and three daughters, J. W. Chedester of Long Beach, F. P. Chedester of Eureka, Mrs. Cora Bullock and Mrs. Edith Oldham of Kansas City, Mrs. Lillie Robb of Holden, Mo., and O. D. Chedester of Cordell, Okla.
